

FOUR YEAR SEQUENCE INFORMATION:

- ECE 201 and RAL 222 are taken as a block in either the 1st or 2nd semester of the sophomore year (or 1st semester of junior year, if needed).
- MTT 202 and MST 202 are taken as a block in either the 1st or 2nd semester of the sophomore year (or 1st semester of junior year, if needed). It is not recommended that both sophomore blocks be taken in the same semester.
- It is recommended that ECE 301, SOM 203, and RAL 322 be taken as a block in the junior year (or 1st semester of senior year, if needed). In the event that this prevents the student from completing major courses, flexibility in scheduling these courses is recommended.
- ECE 490 (Student Teaching) and ECE 498 (Capstone) are taken as a block in the senior year. This is a 3 unit semester and should not be taken with any other courses. One additional unit must be taken in any May Semester, Summer Session or any other semester except Senior Student Teach.
- LIT 310 Literature of Young Readers can be taken in place of ECE 102
